4K Cinematic Multi-Camera Production

Maiara & Maraísa's concert at Sagres Campo Pequeno was one of the largest 4K concert recordings ever made in Portugal. Combining high-energy performance with cutting-edge production, the event demanded seamless execution to capture every moment with cinematic clarity.

Digital Azul Live was responsible for the full audiovisual setup, deploying a sophisticated multi-camera system to ensure a polished, immersive experience. The team utilized 20 Sony 4K cameras, including the Sony FR7 PTZ, FX9, FX6, and FX3, delivering a broadcast that elevated the concert's visual storytelling.

Capturing the Scale and Energy of a Live Music Event

Live music productions at this scale present significant technical and logistical challenges. Coordinating 20 Sony 4K cameras in real-time required precise synchronization to maintain consistent visual quality across multiple angles. The dynamic nature of the stage environment —rapid performer movements, fluctuating lighting conditions, and audience interactions—added another layer of complexity.

To achieve smooth motion capture without disrupting the performance, the team had to strategically position cranes, dolly tracks, and stabilizers. Finally, the production workflow needed to balance live capture with the demands of post-production, ensuring high-quality footage was seamlessly integrated into the final product.

- Seamless Live Coordination A dedicated team of camera operators, vision mixers, and technical directors worked in real-time to adapt to lighting changes, stage movement, and performance pacing.
